First, the six expanded BRICS countries are all the most representative emerging markets and developing countries in the world today.

Second, they have certain advantages in terms of economic strength, influence in regional and international affairs, population size and territorial area, and their overall strength is relatively strong.

Third, the joining of these six countries will more effectively enhance the global and regional representation of BRICS countries. The five previous BRICS members were mainly in Asia, Eurasia, southern Africa and southern America. With the addition of six new members, the representation of BRICS countries in the Middle East, North Africa, the African continent, and the southernmost Americas has been further enhanced and supplemented. These are also densely populated and widely distributed emerging markets and developing countries. wide area.

Fourth, in recent years, the six newly joined countries have adhered to multilateralism, defended the central position of the United Nations in the world, and recognized the principle of BRICS countries to "adhere to true multilateralism and adopt the principles of equality and consensus in decision-making."
